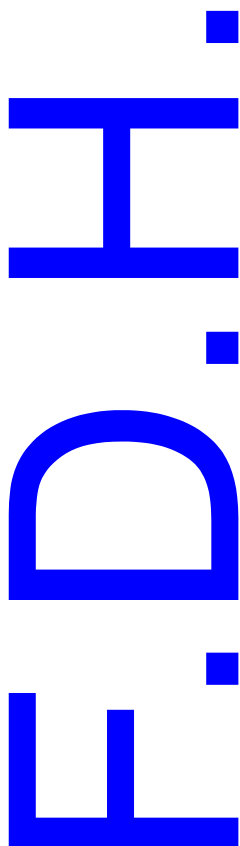


VOLUNTEERING on the Helpline
